### **REQUEST FOR SEED GRANT PROPOSALS**

The Indoor Environment Center invites proposals for seed grants from affiliated faculty. Grants are available for immediate use. It is expected that four awards of up to \$5000 will be made. Seed grants may support undergraduate or graduate assistants, supplies, equipment, travel, and other costs excluding faculty salaries. Grants may co-fund work supported by other sponsors.

Proposals need not be lengthy, but must include the following information:

- Title
- PI name, title, academic unit, and contact information
- Amount requested
- Co-sponsors (if applicable)
- Duration of project
- Project synopsis—objectives and scope, relevance to IEC mission, methods, expected outcome
- Potential to lead to externally funded follow-on activities with identified agencies or organizations
- Collaboration across departmental/college lines (if applicable)

Award recipients must agree to submit a brief report upon completion of the project summarizing the work done and documenting plans for follow-on work.
