







#### Space Features:

- Fixed workstations w/ black epoxy worksurface
- 24' black chalkboard at front
- Full height cabinetry on side walls
- Various safety and other laboratory equipment





#### **Primary Tasks:**

- Learning and Teaching
- Experimentation and Safety

#### Task Locations:

- Workstations
- Chalkboard
- Podium











#### Design Criteria:

- Color Appearance and Color Contrast
  - Critical for experimentation
- Light Distribution on Task Plane
  - Needs to be as even as possible across workstations
- Luminances of Room Surfaces
  - Chalkboard needs to be fairly bright
  - Primary tasks are very low reflectance
- Modeling of Faces and Objects
  - Also critical for experimentation as well as learning









- Recessed linear fluorescent lighting over workstations
- Additional recessed downlights over sink and outer benches
- Wallwashers for cabinetry





- Recessed linear fluorescent lighting over workstations

- Low profile fluorescent wallwasher for chalkboard






#### Space Features:

- 3 story curved white gypsum walls with large windows
- Slotted wood ceiling with cove
- Small café
- Open corridors and balconies
- Carpeted seating and eating area, terrazzo for egress areas







- Entry

















#### Design Criteria:

- Appearance of Space and Luminaires
  - First space guests and most users see
  - Needs to be impressive aesthetically
  - At the same time, needs to be relaxing
- Daylight Integration and Control
  - Large glass area may allow
  - Morning sun may be an issue
- Points of Interest
  - Highlighting work areas, balconies, and banner
- System Flexibility and Control
  - Sufficient light is required for 24 hours a day
  - Several functions in space








- Directional and adjustable pendant lighting with center chandelier
- LED cove lighting (able to do blue, yellow, and white for different scenes
- Downlighting for vestibule





- Directional and adjustable pendant lighting with center chandelier
- LED cove lighting (able to do blue, yellow, and white for different scenes
- Downlighting for vestibule
- Center HID downlighting for 24 hour use
- Uplighting to accent wood ceiling
- Glowing sconces to add interest to walls

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

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






#### Space Features:

- Fixed desks/tables w/ tan worksurface, and wood sides & accents
- Black chalkboard and motorized projection screen at front
- Fixed podium at front
- Back seating without tables in front of sintered aluminum panels





#### **Primary Tasks:**

- Guest Lectures
- Regular Classes and Presentations

#### Task Locations:

- Tables
- Chalkboard
- Podium
- Projection Screen











#### Design Criteria:

- Appearance of Space and Luminaires:
  - Guest lectures and presentations here
- Light Distribution on Task Plane:
  - As even as possible on desks
- Modeling of Faces and Objects:
  - Critical in presentation area (on lecturer and demonstrations)
  - Also needs to be fairly good on audience
- Special Considerations (VDT/Projection Screen):
  - Need to keep as much light off screen as possible
  - Require separate scenes and good optical control of fixtures




#### Bonchek Lecture Hall



- Recessed fluorescent just in front of and over tables
- Wallwashers to accent texture on back walls and for future displays
- Linear fluorescent cove fixture with forward throw optics




#### Bonchek Lecture Hall



- Directional spotlights in front of podium for speaker
- Shielding for any front luminaires to keep light away from projection screen
- Linear chalkboard light






#### Space Features:

- Fireplace with white painted mantel and bluestone hearth
- Movable chairs, sofas, and tables
- Motorized projection screen in front of fireplace
- Dark wood floor with glossy finish
- Acoustical plaster ceiling, yellow walls with white wainscoting





#### **Primary Tasks:**

- Student and Organization Meetings
- Quiet Study and Group Work



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#### Design Criteria:

- Appearances of Space and Luminaires
  - Very high quality of finishes, luminaires need to match
- Daylight Integration and Control
  - South end of building, large glass area on French doors
  - Daylight can overwhelm the space (500+ fc possible throughout space)
- Light Distribution on Surfaces:
  - Non-uniformity on the walls (relaxation)
- Points of Interest:
  - Fireplace is focal point for the room
- System Control and Flexibility:
  - For meetings and for informal use
  - For daytime and nighttime use









- Decorative surface mounted fixture in center of each high ceiling
- Striplights in new cove to light edges of high ceiling
- Sconces mounted on each column



- Goal was to match the styling of current buildings on campus,
- At the same time, making a statement on the campus and giving the building a sense of distinction













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#### Design Criteria:

- Appearance of Space and Luminaires:
  - Façade needs to make a statement for F & M
  - Showing both college pride and sophisticated style
- Direct Glare:
  - Disability glare can hinder sense of security
- Modeling of Faces and Objects:
  - Also critical for security and for aesthetic appeal of facade
- Points of Interest:
  - Pilasters, pediment, entry way





- •Blue LEDs to highlight pilasters and to convey school colors
- •Fluorescent ramp lighting recessed into ramp walls
- •Glowing pediment
- •Poles/bollards at low heights to light walkways





•Interior glows from 24-hour lighting in Atrium





- •Interior glows from 24-hour lighting in Atrium
- •Bollards to light walkways
- •Door highlighted with downlights
