There are several large work spaces to choose from. However, with 15' ceilings and exposed wood joists and columns, the most interesting is the Design Department. It is about 43' x 71' and is shown below in orange. The primary material is gypsum wall board.

The special purpose room is a 30' x 33' training room, which is occasionally used for meetings and conferences. This space is outlined in purple. Its ceiling is acoustical tiles, and its walls are gypsum wall board. The floor is carpeted. This is also the space that I will be using to produce psychological impressions.

The circulation space that I chose is a lobby area and a display area divided by a glass curtain wall. The lobby and display spaces are shown in blue, and are about 30' x 28' and 45' x 28' respectively. The materials consist of hard wood floors and painted gypsum wall board walls and ceilings. I chose this space to be redesigned in conjunction with the facade (above in red) and courtyard (above in green) adjacent to it. Despite the large lobby area, this entrance does not stand out any more than the service entrances. All facades are brick, ground to roof, and are accented by stone window sills. The Lobby will also be the space for which my three schematic design concepts will be produced.

In addition to the four spaces, I would also like to redesign the secondary entrance along the sidewalk, at the bottom of the image. The façade and stairs are shown in green and red, respectively.
