- 1) Wireless Data Networking Card Compatible with 802.11 a, 802.11b, or 802.11g Standard Communication Protocol installed in your Laptop.**
- 2) Virtual Private Network (VPN) Client Graphical User Interface (GUI) Installed on Your Computer:

(you can gain access to this site from a College wireless access point to install the GUI; however, you will not be able to gain general network access without the GUI)**
- 3) Choose the COE\_Wireless**
- 4) WPA Connectivity is also offered in all College of Engineering Buildings**
- 5) Use Your University Access Account ID and Password to Log connect to the Wireless Network**
